## CHAPTER 4 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

## Sec. 4-1. Curfew.

- A. It shall be unlawful for any child under 18 years of age to be on the streets or in public places within the City limits of the City of Waldo between 11 o'clock p.m. and 5 o'clock. a.m., unless attended by a parent or guardian or some adult designated by such parent or guardian.
- B. Any child engaged in a lawful occupation which requires him/her to be on the streets between 11 o'clock p.m. and 5 o'clock a.m. shall not be affected by the provisions of this section; provided, that such child shall carry a written statement from a parent, guardian, or employer stating that the child is employed, the name of the employer and that the child's occupation necessitates his/her being on the streets between 11o'clock p.m. and 5 o'clock a.m.
- C. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Section shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500.00 dollars, or by imprisonment of not more than 60 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- D. There is hereby established a curfew for minors who are under the age of 16 years in the City of Waldo, Florida. The terms and conditions of the curfew are as set out in Florida Statute 877.20 through 877.24 and Sections 82, 83, 84, 86, and 87 of the Chapter 94-209, Florida Session Laws, 1994, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- E. This Section and the curfew shall be enforced by the Waldo Police Department and any other duly qualified law enforcement agency.
